He always has our students and families best interests at heart and is eager to help whenever asked.

Camille is a founding member of KidWorks Women, an auxiliary group committed to furthering the KidWorks mission. For nearly 10 years, Camille has been a classroom volunteer, positively influencing numerous students with her caring nature and consistent presence.

Grant Lottering is the miraculous cyclist who defied death and achieved extraordinary feats. Continuously astounding both the medical profession and audiences, he goes beyond the limits of what is thought to be possible. In addition to his extreme-endurance cycling, Grant is an author, UHSM Ambassador Athlete, and international speaker.

Through his annual 'Im'possible Tours,' Grant has conquered challenging terrains like the French Alps, Pyrenees, South Africa, and the USA, pushing the boundaries of his physical and mental strength. The proceeds from these tours go towards supporting children in underserved communities globally.

Motivated by his newfound purpose in life, Grant consistently achieves what many believe to be impossible. To date, he has shared his story, titled "From Death to the Top of the Alps," with audiences in over 12 countries. Embracing his second chance at life with unwavering determination and without limitations, Grant firmly believes that nothing is impossible with God.

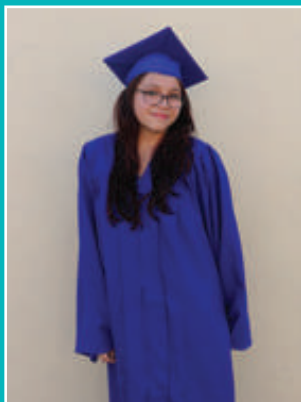

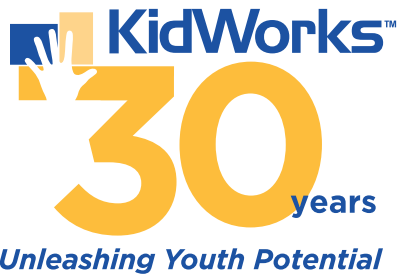
